

LOGGER CLASSIC RULES

All ages - A team trophy is awarded to the championship team. Individual trophies are awarded to championship and runner up teams. Individual trophies are limited to 10 per team. If a championship or runner up team needs more than 10 individual trophies, if asked, a tournament director will provide a name and address for ordering more. This may also be done after the tournament by emailing one of the tournament directors. This is the responsibility of the winning or runner up coach.

IHSA rules apply unless addressed below.

All ages – First, second, third places of each pool and tie-breakers are determined by: 1) best record; 2) head-to-head record; 3) least points allowed in pool play; 4) most points scored in pool play; 5) coin flip. A running clock in the 4th quarter will occur if the score differs by 20 points or more. The clock will only stop for timeouts or injured players only for the remainder of the game.

All ages - Wild card teams will not play a team from their pool in any **semi final** game. The next higher alpha will play the wildcard. For example, pool A winner is to play the wild card. The wild card is also from pool A. Pool B will play the wildcard from pool A and the pool A winner will play pool C winner. Another example is pool B winner is to play the wild card. The wild card is also from pool B. Pool C will play the wildcard from pool B and the pool A winner will play pool B winner.

4th, 5th and 6th Grades - 6 minute quarters with clock stopping on all dead ball situations. Each team receives 2 full (1 minute) time outs and one 20 second time out per game with no carryovers to overtimes (OT). Each OT a team is awarded a 20 second time. Any unused timeouts, from official game or previous overtime, are forfeited. There are no carryovers from the original game to an OT or previous OT to another OT. A regulation sized basketball will be provided by the tournament for all 5th grade and above boy's games. All girls' games will use 28.5 regulation sized basketball provided by the tournament.

7th Grade - 7 minute quarters.....everything else directly above remains the same.

8th Grade - 8 minute quarters.....everything else directly above remains the same.

4th Grade Boys only - **A 28.5 ball will be provided by the tournament.** Pressing is allowed only in the last 2 minutes of the 2nd and 4th quarters and all overtimes. Once a team has a lead of 20 or more points, the leading team may not press. If the lead falls below 15 points the leading team may once again press.

Outside food and drink are not allowed at any of the facilities. **This will be enforced.** This is the rule of the facilities, not the tournament. Each facility has full service concessions. Please support our facility's concession stands. They do a lot to make our tournament so successful.

Any tournament/facility/direction/scheduling concerns **prior to the tournament starting** should be directed to Mark or Loren. There is 1 minute between quarters, 2 minute halves and 5 minutes between games or posted game time. A game will not start early but the 5 minutes between games may be modified at the discretion of the facility director. Please be on time for your games. If a team is late for their scheduled game, forfeiture is at the discretion of the facility director and/or the tournament directors.

Facility director's names will be provided to each head coach. Any facility or game concern should be discussed with them. If a resolution is not attained, please call Loren or Mark. Mark and Loren are also working sites, but will be available if needed. Please do everything you can as a coach/parent/facility director to resolve any situation prior to contacting Loren and Mark. This has been discussed with the facility directors also.

Unsportsmanlike behavior is not tolerated. Please be on your best behavior and ask your parents and players also. Coaches will be asked to control their team's fans when needed. If the coaches are not successful, the fan(s) will be removed. **Coaches are responsible for their fans and players.**
